





“The most important thing about the World Game is knowing you’ve connected with a global coaching community that is there to share their support and expertise with you. It becomes all about ‘we’ and we can see that together, we can make an even greater impact than we ever imagined.”

The idea of giving back when you graduate and creating a movement is encouraged amongst all Coachnesia The Art & Science of Coaching™ graduates, and it’s something they’ve been championing for a long time. With Josef and Meity attending different World Game conferences, they were able to share their movements with a large (global) group and inspire others to create an infinite loop of coaching skills and techniques being shared with more and more people.

Josef’s World Game team created ‘The Butterfly Effects’, a #coaching4students movement that facilitated coaching sessions with 30+ university students, representing 27 different provinces in Indonesia. Those 30 students, in turn, were asked to deliver a minimum of 3 coaching sessions to a wider group of 5 - 10 people.

All in all, that led to a group of 100+ new students being exposed to the power of coaching and leadership skills.

Josef has a motto in life that applies so beautifully to the World Game philosophy:
“Be yourself, but better every day,” he explains.
“We’re all unique, with our own strengths, and to be better every day, we need to open ourselves to learn from others around us.”

“I cannot even begin to explain the incredible vibe and energy you get from the World Game. It was an amazing experience to meet coaches from all over the world! And then there’s meeting Marilyn in person, and experiencing her energetic aura and the power that she has to motivate and inspire people. All I can say is ‘wow!’”

Last year, following the World Game, Meity and various members of the Coachnesia Team continued their tradition of forming a movement to give back.

They chose to help raise ecological awareness amongst 20-30 employees and family members in a gold mining community in West Java. First, they planted trees in the area, to give back to the earth some of what mining takes out, and then they proceeded to coach the employees about the importance of ecological conservation efforts.

They did the same in a second project where they approached a group of Agricultural Institute students to raise awareness about what positive ecological impacts they could have after they graduate.

“In Indonesia, topics like education and food are of course much more of a priority,” Meity explains, “so the work can be challenging at times, but if we don’t start now, then when?”



“Our focus has been on how we can all ‘think globally, but act locally’. And our group support of all of our individual local efforts has been phenomenal, and perhaps most importantly of all, we meet regularly and we’re keeping the coaching conversations alive.”

“I would tell anyone interested in the World Game to go! It’s a wonderful chance to learn, get inspired, and discover ways to expand your capacity to improve aspects in your community, city, and country through coaching skills.”

Iaci and her team's work has received great World Game recognition over the years. One project in particular focused on helping Instituto Prof, a group that takes care of young children during the day in Paraisópolis, a large ‘favela’ (informal settlement) in the middle of São Paulo, Brazil.

Instituto Prof teaches the kids (aged 7-10) things they don’t learn in school, like art, ballet, sports, music, self presentation, confidence, courage and commitment, and they’re always in need of help.

Iaci and her Erickson Brazil team gifted the teachers a free The Art & Science of Coaching™ course, and the results have been amazing.

“The teachers really enjoyed the training, and one of the main reasons was that they learned to listen to their students! They began to realize how much autonomy they had and that giving them this space resulted in more interest and motivation in class.”

“On the first day of school of the year, after completing our training, the math teacher welcomed the students and showed them all the content they were supposed to learn in the semester. Then he asked them: ‘How do you want to learn this?’ and it ended up being the students who created the lesson plan!”





